



Dress Code

St. Theresa Catholic School is a respectful, faith-based learning environment. We ask that students dress appropriately to ensure that all students feel comfortable within our school.

Students are expected to dress in a clean, neat and appropriate manner, which includes the following:

- ◆ Clothing is free of offensive words, slogans or pictures.
- ◆ Shorts and skirts should cover the buttocks fully
- ◆ Pants or shorts should not reveal any underwear.
- ◆ Shirts should not be low cut , or reveal the midriff
- ◆ Spaghetti straps are allowed
- ◆ No strapless shirts allowed
- ◆ Hats are not permitted in school, unless there is a special occasion

Any student who does not abide by the dress code:

1. Will be asked to change into gym clothing, or be given a shirt or pair of pants to wear.
2. Will receive a phone call to his/her parents to pick up their child so that the student can change.
3. Can be given a detention.
