

Dress Code

St. Theresa Catholic School is a respectful, faith-based learning

environment. We ask that students dress appropriately to ensure that all students feel comfortable within our school.

Students are expected to dress in a clean, neat and appropriate manner, which includes the following:

- Clothing is free of offensive words, slogans or pictures.
- Shorts and skirts should cover the buttocks fully
- Pants or shorts should not reveal any underwear.
- Shirts should not be low cut, or reveal the midriff
- Spaghetti straps are allowed
- No strapless shirts allowed
- Hats are not permitted in school, unless there is a special occasion

Any student who does not abide by the dress code:

- 1. Will be asked to change into gym clothing, or be given a shirt or pair of pants to wear.
- 2. Will receive a phone call to his/her parents to pick up their child so that the student can change.
- 3. Can be given a detention.
