Open to grades 5- 8 for the 2019-2020 school year at OLPH and St. Theresa Middle Schools

- English stream Grade 7 & 8 students take 1 additional option per term, or 1 full year optional course
- All classes will be supervised by certified teachers
- Whenever possible professionals in the arts will be employed to conduct workshops
